





In what year were you born? (Please enter 4-digit year.)







- Males were a larger percentage of survey takers than in years past.






















MOBILITY AND PEDESTRIAN ENHANCEMENTS

Which of the following Caroline Street improvements would you like to see in future capital improvement projects? (Choose all that apply.)



Which of the following parking policy changes would you support to encourage more economic development and support local business? (Choose all that apply.)


